Dairy Month



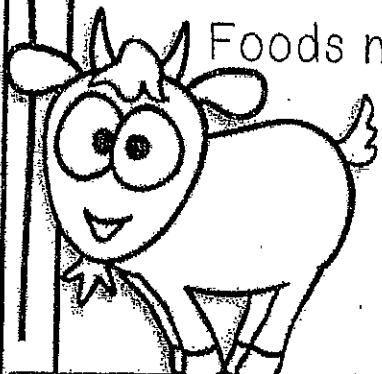
In America, a dairy cow is white with black spots and can make 5 gallons of milk a day!

June is a time when people celebrate dairy foods. It is National Dairy Month. Dairy foods are made with the milk of mammals. Most dairy foods we eat come from cow's milk. Dairy products are important. They help keep us healthy.

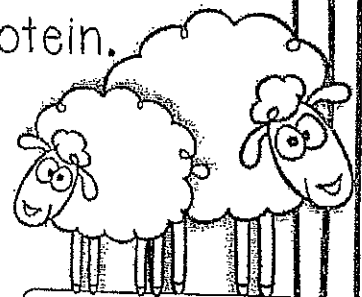
Do you like cheese or ice cream? Did you say, YES? If so, then you like dairy foods. There are many kinds of dairy foods. There are chocolate and low-fat milks. Cottage cheese is in this group. Yogurt is also in this category.

Dairy foods are nutritious. Milk products have vitamins A and D. They are needed for good health.

Foods made with milk have calcium. It builds strong bones. Dairy products have protein. It helps muscles grow. People need three servings of dairy each day.



Some people cannot drink cow's milk. They might drink goat's milk.



Sheep milk is used to make some types of cheese.

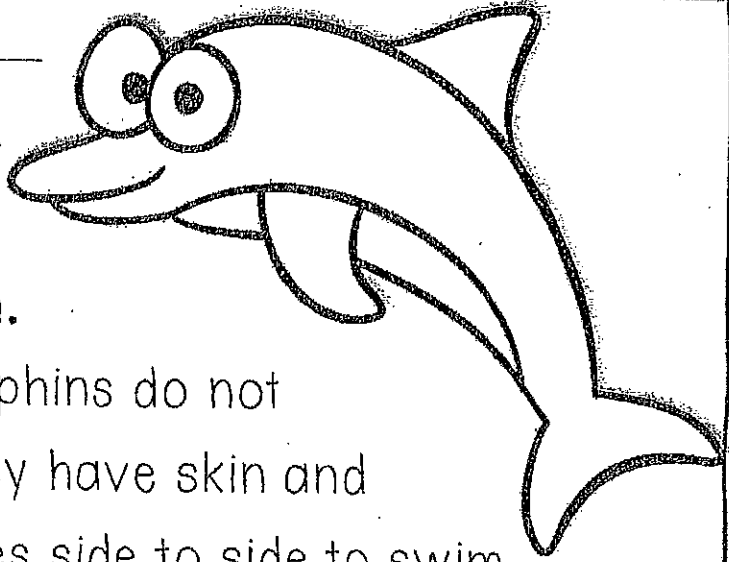

Dolphins



Dolphins are not fish.

They are mammals. Dolphins do not have scales or gills. They have skin and breathe air. A fish moves side to side to swim.

Dolphins swim by **shifting** their tails up and down.

Dolphins live in groups called pods. They can be trained by people. Dolphins whistle and make clicks. This **wards** off danger. Dolphins eat fish and squid.

A baby dolphin is called a calf. When a calf is born, it will be pushed up to take its first breath. Soon, the calf will make **vocal** noises.

Dolphins **locate** things by making echoes. The sounds spring off things. These sounds come back to the dolphin. It lets them know where everything is.

Dozens to hundreds of dolphins can live together in a pod.
Some people call a group of dolphins a school instead of a pod.
