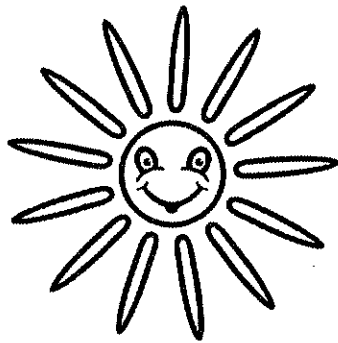

2. You will read *The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane* by Kate DiCamillo and complete the packet. The packet consists of a one-sentence summary for each chapter of the novel, a character trait chart, and a book review.
3. All students are to choose one book from the following list. Read it and then complete the attached book report.
4. The book reports that are typed should be printed in black ink. The font should be easy to read in both size and style. You may also choose to write your reports by hand in neat cursive on looseleaf. Please do not write them on paper that is not lined.

 - *Escape From Mr. Lemoncello's Library* by Chris Grabenstein
 - *Flora and Ulysses* by Kate DiCamillo
