

Kindergarten to First Grade Summer Packet 2022

The children have done a terrific job this year. In order to help them stay on track during the summer, you should spend some time each week doing "school work". You should spend 20 to 30 minutes two or three times a week doing some activity, especially on those rainy days. Below is a list of ideas.

Language Arts

- Review card box words
- Read predecodable books
- Use letters in card box to build words
- Practice letter sounds, especially vowels
- Use the leftover pages from handwriting book
- Coloring (to keep that hand strong)
- Writing letters and numbers on lined paper
- Writing full name on lined paper
- Letter or number search from signs while driving in a car

Math

- You can use everyday activities to reinforce math concepts. The concepts include patterns, shapes, identifying and writing numbers, money, time, addition, and subtraction.
- Do the extra pages in your math workbooks, especially the math facts practice pages
- Ask your child to tell you the time by using a digital clock or time to the hour using an analog clock.
- Count out money using pennies, nickels, and dimes when buying summer treats.
- Search for flat shapes and solid shapes when driving in the car: circle, square, rectangle, triangle, hexagon, cube, sphere, cylinder, cone.
- Practice counting by 2's, 5's, and 10's.
- Do leftover pages in the math workbook
- Have your child fill in a blank calendar with the numbers for each summer month. Fill in the calendar with all of your summer events! We have included blank calendars in this pack.
- Addition and Subtraction flash cards or games up to sums of ten.
